Dear Seniors, Parents or Guardians,

This letter is to inform you of the scholarship opportunities offered this year by the **Burlington Community Scholarship Foundation**. The application will be available after March 1 at the following locations: Burlington High School Guidance Office, Shawsheen Technical High School, Burlington Town Hall, and also on line at www.burlington.org under schools. The application deadline is **March 31, 2007**. The scholarships available for undergraduate degrees are listed below.

1. The **Carl Cyr Award** - \$2,000 awarded to a graduating high school senior residing in Burlington.
2. The **Brendan Curtin Memorial Scholarship** - \$2,000 awarded to a graduating high school senior residing in Burlington and preparing for a career in medicine or related field. Donated by the Brendan Curtin Memorial Scholarship Fund.
3. The **Brendan Curtin Memorial Scholarship** - \$2,000 awarded to a graduating high school senior residing in Burlington who has shown a commitment to the Town of Burlington through community service. Donated by the Brendan Curtin Memorial Scholarship Fund.
4. The **Charles Curtin Memorial Scholarship** - \$2,000 awarded to a graduating high school senior residing in Burlington planning to major in accounting or business. Donated by the Brendan Curtin Memorial Scholarship Fund.
5. The **Harold R. Ellis Memorial Scholarships** - \$2,000 awarded to two graduating Burlington High School seniors residing in Burlington—two @ \$2,000. Donated by the Harold R. Ellis Memorial Scholarship Fund.
6. The **Jack Blais Scholarships** - \$2,000 awarded to two graduating high school seniors residing in Burlington who are planning to major in science or engineering—two @ \$2,000.
7. The **John C. Rennie Education Scholarship** - \$2,000 awarded to a high school senior residing in Burlington who is planning to pursue a career in education.
8. **Thomas E. & Jessica C. Murray Memorial Scholarships** donated by the Robert W. Murray Charitable Trust—four @ \$2,000.
 - a) Awarded to a student residing in Burlington who is a son/daughter of a town employee and who has been involved in community service and who intends to go on to higher education. (Two awards)
 - b) Awarded to a student residing in Burlington who has been involved in community service and who intends to go on to higher education.
 - c) Awarded to a student residing in Burlington who intends to pursue a career in culinary arts.
9. **Ernest DeMartinis Memorial Scholarship** - \$2,000 awarded to a high school student entering the field of media, communications, TV production.
10. **Joan Miles Scholarship** - \$2,000 awarded to a student who has demonstrated a proficiency in art or creative writing and has made an outstanding contribution to high school life and to the community beyond.
11. **Stephen Miles Scholarship** - \$2000 awarded to a graduating high school senior residing in Burlington who will be pursuing a degree in art or an art related field.
12. **Harold Dulong Memorial Scholarship** - \$2,000 awarded to a student who has demonstrated care & concern to other people and shows a commitment to the Town of Burlington through involvement of Community Service.

13. The **BCSF Scholarship** - \$2,000 awarded to a student who will be attending a two-year college.
14. **BCSF Discretionary Award** – Two \$2,000 awards given to a deserving student who resides in Burlington and intends to go on to higher education.
15. **BCSF Exemplary Community Service Award** – Two \$2,000 awards given to a student who resides in Burlington and has demonstrated a commitment to serving the community.
16. **BCSF Special Recognition Award** - \$2,000 awarded to a high school student who resides in Burlington.
16. **The Joan Corrao Scholarship** - \$2000 awarded to a graduating high school senior residing in Burlington who has been involved in community service and intends to pursue a college education.
17. **The Lucy Damiani Scholarship** - \$2000 awarded to a graduating high school senior residing in Burlington who is pursuing a degree in education, humanities or religious studies.
18. **BCSF Scholarship** - Two \$1000 awards open to a graduating high school senior residing in Burlington who will be going on to a technical/trade school or 2 year college.
19. **BCSF Scholarship** - \$2000 awarded to a graduating high school senior residing in Burlington who will be pursuing a degree in music, performing arts or theatre.
20. **BCSF Scholarship** - \$2000 awarded to a graduating high school senior residing in Burlington who will be pursuing a degree in computer science or robotics.

***The Wayne Alan Johnson Scholarships** - awarded to graduating Burlington High School seniors who have demonstrated academic improvement, a concern for his/her fellow students, who intends to pursue a career in criminal justice or furthering their education, and can demonstrate financial need under Unusual Circumstances on the application—two @ \$2,000. Donated by the Wayne Alan Johnson Memorial Scholarship Fund.
