Re: Burlington – Substructure Repairs to Bridge B-29-007 - I95/ST128 over Middlesex Turnpike

Dear Administrator Sagarino,

I am pleased to inform you that the District has received authorization to expend additional non-federal aid funding for use in implementing limited scope maintenance actions to state highway assets within District 4. These funds are budgeted from the current state fiscal year that ends June 30, 2019. Based on a review of the existing conditions of the concrete substructure, the District has chosen to use a portion of the funding to make repairs to the I95/ST128 bridge over the Middlesex Turnpike.

In general, the maintenance work consists of chipping off deteriorated concrete and replacing with new concrete on the bridge piers and columns. This work is anticipated to start early this spring and is anticipated to be completed in early July. Nightly lane closures on the Middlesex Turnpike are projected.

I wanted to make you aware of this pending investment within your community and ask that you share this information with the community's emergency services divisions and any other local officials or departments who may have an interest in the matter.
