

The Marion Tavern at Grand View Farm is part of the historical and cultural heart of Burlington. Its origin dates to a 1770 saltbox structure. Through the years the building evolved, its present architecture stands as an example of a 19<sup>th</sup> century connected-farm complex. Having served at times as a farm and a stagecoach tavern, the property's history mirrors Burlington's ever-changing response to the economic needs of the day.

In 2002 the Town of Burlington obtained the Marion Tavern at Grand View Farm in a three-way land swap between the town, the most recent owner and a local developer. The town is committed to restoring the main house to its original condition. Once renovated, it is envisioned that the building will serve as a self-sustaining function facility. In order to achieve this goal, a major fund raising effort has been initiated. We are asking the citizens and businesses of Burlington to participate.

The Friends of the Marion Tavern is a nonprofit organization chartered under section 501(3)c.

It's mission is to preserve and restore The Marion Tavern at Grand View Farm by establishing a self-sustaining cornerstone of Burlington's legacy for the benefit and enjoyment of our citizens and future generations

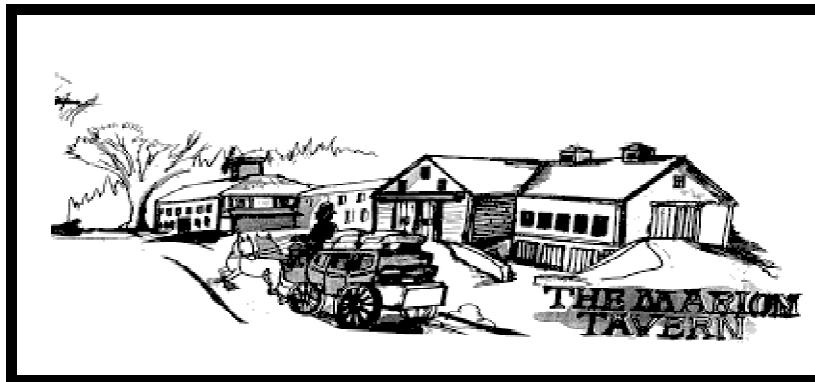
