Until we have Chris Warren's update, the committee decided to postpone voting on our committee's final report.

Steve is still assembling the photos of Cambridge Street sidewalks (taken by John and Bud Larson, Steve Morin and Adam Senesi). These will be part of our document for Representative Ken Gordon in hopes of getting state assistance to bring that state roadway's sidewalks up to safely satisfactory condition.

We went over our report drafts—using the figure \$250,000 as a placeholder for the annual amount we feel should be suggested for Town Meeting's consideration (since our numbers have varied in various discussions). We agreed that our report should be crisp and informative; we don't want a number to become the opening of a debate.

Adam has agreed to tell Bill Beyer our feeling that at least a core of this sidewalk committee should be kept intact if Town Meeting supports having our group become a standing committee.

We went over all the Sidewalk Committee minutes from February through June, voting their acceptance after discussion and clarifications.

Steve will let us know the time and place for a September meeting prior to Town Meeting. Our agenda: to finalize our committee report of the year's work.
