

Burlington Town Common

Electrical Replacement

The Burlington Parks and Recreation Department will begin working on the Town Common electrical replacement the week of October 9, 2017. The work is the result of a Fall 2017 Town Meeting warrant article and includes the replacement of the electrical system on the Town Common. The work will be performed by Brothers Electric Corporation and is expected to be completed by November 17, 2017. The new electrical system will have one source feeding the common and will be installed according to current codes. The lights and circuits will be on fully programmable times and will be expandable for future needs.

During the course of the work, the electricity to the Town Common will be shut off. This means the outlets and walkway lights on the common will not be operational and the common will not be lit at night. There were no plans or as-builts for the original electricity so the contractor is forced to completely shut off the electricity for safety reasons.
