**ARTICLE 3**

**RE: Amend Zoning Bylaw Article II  
"Definitions" Body Art**

Section 2.6.1 Body Art

"The practice of physical body adornment by licensed practitioners utilizing techniques including, but not limited to, body piercing, tattooing, cosmetic tattooing, branding and scarification. Body piercing shall include puncturing or penetrating the skin of a person, not including the ear, for the purpose of inserting jewelry or other adornment. No practitioner of body art shall practice, and no establishment in which body art is applied shall be operated without a license issued by the Board of Health. Where the practice of body art occupies less than 25 percent of a personal service business as defined under

Section 4.2.6.1 of this bylaw, it shall be considered as an accessory use permitted by right. Where the practice of body art occupies more than 25 percent of the floor area of a business, it shall be considered as a principal use and regulated under Section 4.2.6.30 of this bylaw.”

And further to amend Article IV “USE REGULATIONS”, Section 4.2.6 “Retail, Consumer and Trade Uses”, to include the following use:

Section 4.2.6.30 “Body Art”, and to permit such use by Special Permit in the Continuous Traffic (BT) District, and to prohibit the use in all other zoning districts, except that the use shall be permitted in the Aquifer and Water Resource Overlay Districts.
