ARTICLE 1

RE: Bond Authorization

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate \$10,609,650 or some other amount to pay costs of constructing, reconstructing, making extraordinary repairs, originally equipping and furnishing the Wildwood Elementary School to convert it to a Kindergarten Center, including payment of all other costs incidental and related thereto, and to determine whether this appropriation should be raised by taxation, by transfer from available funds, by borrowing, or otherwise; or to act in any manner in relation thereto.

ARTICLE 4

ARTICLE 7

RE: School Enrollment/Space Assessment

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, or otherwise provide the sum of \$50,000, or any other sum, for the purpose of funding an independent outside assessment of the Town's school enrollment and space needs, both current and projected and to assist the Town in formulating a comprehensive plan to address all of the needs including K-5, Marshall Simonds and High School. Such assessment shall be overseen by a committee consisting of two members selected by the Board of Selectmen, two members selected by the School Board and one member to be named by the Moderator or to act in any manner in relation thereto.
