Burlington Transit Meeting July 31, 2019 Minutes

Present: Barbara L'Heureux, Jen Gelinias, Sonia Rollins, Patti Robichaud, Mike Runyan, Millie Nash, Marge McDonald & John Sanchez

John Sanchez described the Tri-Town effort of Burlington, Bedford and Lexington's transportation systems to solve the problem of ridership decline. Subsequently, Marge McDonald and John Sanchez explained the Subsidy Transportation Pilot Program by the Town for residents who qualify.

This Program is to provide financial assistance to the elderly, disabled and/or household income eligible residents of the Town to meet their transportation needs. The Council of Aging will administer funds to eligible Town residents to supplement their transportation costs needed for accessing jobs, medical appointments or general transportation needs.

Funds will be granted based on the individual's frequency of transportation needs, subject to verification and audit by the Town.

A unanimous vote was taken for recommending moving ahead with Pilot Program – 6-0
