# Software company opens new headquarters

A Burlington-based software company recently held a ribbon-cutting ceremony and luncheon to celebrate the opening of its new facility. HealthEdge, which provides administrative and financial software to health care payers, recently moved its corporate headquarters from a 16,500-square-foot space on 3 Van de Graaff Drive to a new 28,000-square-foot space at 30 Corporate Drive in the Burlington Centre office park. HealthEdge's employee count has increased by 140 jobs since June 2012 — between its offices in Burlington and Powell, Ohio — with another 40 open positions still to be filled, according to the company. Currently, it employs 165 people in Burlington. Additionally, the company announced in October that Fifth Street Technology Partners had made a \$17.5 million growth investment, part of a larger agreement that also provided HealthEdge with an expanded line of credit with Silicon Valley Bank. In December 2012, HealthEdge completed the acquisition of a care management technology company, Click4Care. US Representative John F. Tierney, a Salem Democrat, and state Representative Kenneth Gordon, a Bedford Democrat, were among those who took part in the recent ribbon-cutting, joining Burlington officials, company employees, and board members from the Burlington Area Chamber of Commerce.
