



COVID-19 Update | July 2020

Dear Client,

Thank you for your continued support during these unprecedented times of change and uncertainty influencing our way of life. We wanted to inform you about the new policies and procedures we have been making with regards to the COVID-19 situation and reiterate our commitment to safety:

1. Shooting lanes and participants will be spaced out 6' apart throughout the class.
2. Spectators will remain in their car or kept back outside the perimeters of the range to maintain gatherings of 10 people or less, including instructors.
3. Instructors are required to have a bandana or face covering on person, but are not required to wear one if a social distance of at least 6' is maintained when communicating to participants.
4. It is recommended that students are not required to wear masks due to the safety hazard of string interference upon anchoring close to the face and the potential likelihood of an injury (e.g. the mask causing more harm than good in this scenario). If an individual chooses to wear a mask, it is recommended that a bandana or mask without string attachments is chosen.
5. Individual ground quivers with bow hooks will be used instead of the free standing main bow racks.
6. All equipment will be disinfected after each session using denatured alcohol diluted with water and also a peroxide mix and disposable papertowels. Specifically, they will be cleaned via spray directly to the papertowel and then a swipe of the riser / string / arrow shafts to prevent damage via cumulative effect.
7. Target faces will be cleaned with a disinfectant wipe after each session.
8. The same equipment must not be used consecutively after each session.
  - Example: If the set of labeled "A" bows are used during Session 1, 12:00 - 1:30 pm, they will be disinfected and temporarily stored, but not assigned to any participants immediately joining Session 2, 1:40 - 3:10 pm. However, they are cleared for use again for participants joining Session 3, 3:30 – 5:00 pm.
9. Each archer will be assigned their own individual target, numbered with a cone or spot marker and labeled on the actual stand.
