

Water Main Flushing Program

The Water Main Flushing Program will begin on May 1st and will continue for the next 6 to 8 weeks. This program is accomplished by flushing water through the fire hydrants, which will help to circulate the water in the distribution system. Some flushing will take place at night, but the majority will be done during the day. You may observe some discolored water during this time. It will clear up in a short time by running your faucets. The end result will be a better quality of drinking water for Burlington residents.

Water Main Flushing Program Schedule:

- May 1-5 Winnmere Section from Center Street to the Woburn town line.
- May 5-7 Beacon St area, Peach Orchard Road area, and Locust Street area.
- May 7-9 Chandler Road area, Mill Street area to the Wilmington Town Line.
- May 12 - 15 Skilton Lane area, Thomas Street area, Sears Street area, Taylor Ave., Nelson Road areas through to Wilmington Road.
- May 16 - 20 Fox Hill area to Wilmington Town Line, on the east side of Fox Hill.
- May 21 - 23 West side of Fox Hill to Wilmington Road to the Wilmington Town Line.
- May 27 - 31 North side of Wilmington Road from Cambridge Street to the Wilmington Town Line and north through the Leroy Drive area to Billerica.
- June 2 - 4 Francis Wyman Road and all areas west to Billerica and Bedford Town Lines.
- June 5 - 9 St. Mary's area, Wing Terrace, Skelton, Country Road areas, Carey Ave. area, University Ave., Cedar areas.
- June 10 - 13 Pathwoods, Great Pines, Terry Ave., Church Lane area, Fairfax St. area and Bedford Street from the Town Common to the Bedford Town Line.
- June 16 - 20 All areas between Bedford Street, through Terrace Hall to Lexington Street east to Mall Road, from Middlesex Turnpike to Cambridge Street
- June 23 - 30 Mall Road, Cambridge Street, Ray Avenue, Muller Road area, South Bedford Street and Blanchard Road, Wheeler areas, Middlesex Turnpike through Network Drive and the industrial park to Adams Street area.
