Stop Sign:

The request for a stop sign at the intersection of Stanwood, Richfield and Wheatland was reviewed.

The Traffic Advisory Committee sent information that they follow the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) recommendations and any further recommendation would need BOS approval.

Selectman Tigges said he was not confident that this site warranted a stop sign and said that each of the streets were dead ends making it difficult to speed in that neighborhood even with the S curve and that there are not many vehicles that pass through those streets, in his experience.

Selectman Hogan stated that a sign discussion had taken place regarding another location because vehicles were passing through as a cut through and was not convinced a sign be in place at this location in accordance with MUTCD.

The automobile subcommittee was satisfied with the departmental response and concurred with the MUTCD and were not ready at this time to recommend to the full board that a stop sign be installed at one of these intersections that do not touch a main road.

It was recommended that a letter be sent to the requester of the sign to let him know of the decision of the subcommittee and that he could still contact the office to request to be on the agenda to come before the full board.
