We discussed the opening date at the Museum, with a potential opening date in May. Prior to the opening day to the public, we made plans to rearrange some large furniture and other objects to make the walking aisles more comfortable. We have a target date of April 17 to meet at the Museum at 10 a.m.There will be advertising in local newspapers and social media to invite new members. As the 250th Anniversary approaches in 2026, we are appointing members and forming subcommittees to begin the research for the celebration.

Learned that Kent House on Middlesex Turnpike will have to be rezoned as residential. Nordblom has been before the Planning Board with a concept of the Kent House remaining, with new construction of townhouses on both sides. Good to know that the Kent House will stay.
