How Do I qualify?

Age 60 or over

or

Disability

or

Income

Disability—we just need a medical professional to write a letter.

Income—300% of the Federal Poverty level or \$38,280/year

You only need to meet one criteria to qualify.

GENERAL INFORMATION

You will receive either 35 or 50 rides per month depending on your projected usage.

You are responsible for the first \$1 of your ride and the town of Burlington will cover the next \$10.

You are then responsible for anything over that beginning at \$11.01

You will need to download the Lyft app or sign up with GoGo Technologies.

You will need a credit card or gift card to use either one.

You may use the service any time of the day or night and any day of the week.

Rides must start or end in Burlington

Rides are automatically uploaded into participants accounts every month and expire at the end of every month.

Prices will vary due to time of day, traffic conditions availability of drivers, weather and other events around town.

HOW IT WORKS

Fill out an application. Once approved Download the app on to your phone.

When you are ready for a ride, open the app and type in your destination address. Choose what type of vehicle you want. The app will then ask you to confirm your pickup spot. (ie. The mall, which entrance or at the senior center front or back) You then tap to “confirm and request” the ride.

The Council on Aging will have volunteers available by appointment to help you with everything from downloading the app to taking your first ride.

If you are unable to download an app onto your cellphone you may sign up with GoGo Technologies.
