DAY CAMP SESSION

Day Camp sessions begin with check-in at Burlington Recreation Center from 2:30 P.M. ending in the afternoon with check-out at 4:30 P.M.

WHAT TO BRING

Please read carefully and make sure to have all the following items daily. We appreciate your attention to this list:

Small day/backpack- (in which all the following items fit into)

Water bottle

Comfortable shoes and clothing to be worn without fear of getting messy

Please note- wear clothing that can & will get dirty. Make sure to have the camper's name clearly written on all personal items. This is important to make sure all of your items return home with you, plus keep our valued attention with your camper and not on their gear. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

DISCIPLINE

We expect campers to follow the established code of conduct expressed to campers by staff members. Any camper behavior showing disrespect or disobedience to these guidelines will result in appropriate discipline. Staff members will be the first individual to deal with camper behavior problems. If a camper continues negative behavior, the staff member will notify his/her staff director for assistance. If negative behavior continues, the staff director will notify the parents by phone call after the staff director speaks with the camper. The camp will contact you if your child is unwilling to change his/her behavior, shows a pattern of disobedience, exhibits violent, disruptive behavior or is assaulting (i.e. physically or verbally) other campers. Campers who assault other campers will be dismissed from camp programs without refund.

ILLNESS AND COMMUNICABLE DISEASES

Children who have symptoms of a communicable disease should be seen by their pediatrician. In order to prevent the spread of communicable diseases and to ensure rapid recovery, it is advisable to keep a child home from school when they show symptoms such as vomiting, diarrhea, fever over 100°, chills, congestive cough, runny nose, sore throat, or skin eruptions, etc. Your child should be symptom-free for at least 24 hours before returning to school. If these symptoms are identified at school, the parents will be notified and your child will be sent home.
