



Regan Park Place 2021!

Regan Park, is a *free* summer program offered by the Burlington Recreation Department that offers children the opportunity to participate in fun and safe outdoor games, sports, and arts and crafts.

Who: Children who have completed grades K-5 and must be Burlington residents

Where: Regan Park on Sumpter Ave. off Route 3A (Cambridge St.)

When: June 28-August 13, Monday-Friday (closed July 5th)

Time: 8:30 am to 4:30 pm

REGISTRATION

Pre-registration is required to attend Regan Park Place. You must pre register through Burlington Parks and Recreation.

DAILY SCHEDULE

9am - DROP OFF: Please do not drop your child off early, as we will be busy setting up for the day and will not be able to provide proper supervision. Staff is not responsible for children dropped off prior to the program start time.

10:15am – SNACK TIME: Before our bigger games, the children can have a quick break to have a snack. This gives the children an opportunity to drink plenty of water and a little bit of free time.

12pm - LUNCH: If your child will remain at the park, please provide them with a lunch in a solid lunch box. We are unable to supply your child with food.

Appx 1:30pm ICE CREAM MAN: Please provide your child with a few dollars if they are allowed to buy an ice cream, candy, or a drink.

3pm - CLOSING/PICK UP: Children can be picked up anytime during the day. Our staff and volunteers are not expected to stay past 3, so please be considerate by arriving on time. Don't forget to have your child say goodbye before they leave so we know they have left with a trusted adult.

SPECIAL EVENTS

Weather permitting, we will be scheduling water activities, such as a slip and slide. Please be sure they are dressed for the weather and bring sunscreen, a bathing suit, and bug spray.

RAINY DAYS

Rainy days may force us inside at our rain location which is Burlington High School Cafeteria. This is our rain location Monday through Thursday. We do not have a rain location on Fridays. If it is raining prior to our start time, call the Recreation Department at **(781) 270-1695** and press **3** to find out where we will be.

MISCELLANEOUS

If your child needs extra support this summer, please let us know or call the Recreation Department. The staff at Regan Park work with support staff so your child is able to fully participate.

As the weather becomes increasingly hot and humid, keeping the children hydrated is one of the main concerns of the counselors. We do take water breaks after every game so that the participants can stay hydrated. Many children use up their water early in the sessions. As a reminder, the staff encourages the participants to bring multiple water bottles or bring a reusable bottle to fill up during the day.

All staff are certified in First Aid and CPR and are able to administer it, if necessary. **Please be sure to note any allergies, illnesses, or medications your child has when registering.** Your child should bring anything they may need, like inhalers or Epi-Pen, and know how to use it.

EXPECTATIONS

Your child's safety is the most important thing for the staff at Regan Park. By meeting our expectations, we can all have a safe, fun summer. Here are a few of our main rules:

1. Be respectful to everyone at the park.
2. Listen to and follow instructions given by staff or volunteers.
3. Keep your hands to yourself.

Treat Others the Way You Want to be Treated!

Expectations will be communicated to the children at Regan Park and altered as needed. Children who do not adhere to the expectations will have to sit out of the activity for a short period of time. If issues escalate, the Recreation Department and parents will be notified to determine next steps.
